

Net Prologue and Closure for a RACES Training Net

This is (NCS call sign) Orleans County Net Control in the Radio Amateur Civil Emergency Service, operating on 145.270mhz negative offset and a pl of 141.3 by authority of the Federal Communications Commission and the Commissioner of the State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services. This is a directed net, alerted for the purpose of a RACES training drill. All stations are welcome to join us and are encouraged to do so....OUT

Announce what form is used if any

Any stations with traffic of a higher than ROUTINE precedence, call now giving your call phonetically...OVER.

This is (NCS Call Sign), net control. I now request all other stations with or without traffic to check in now giving your call phonetically...OVER.

I ROGER the following stations (calling stations. Call signs are given phonetically)

Appoint a assistant NCS.

All stations prepare to copy Drill message...OUT.

Would (assistant NCS station) read back the message...OVER.

Are there any stations requiring fills or corrections...OVER.

Do necessary fills or corrections.

All stations ROGER the message in the order you checked in beginning with (call sign)...OVER.

This is (NCS call sign), net control for the Orleans County RACES net. Are there any other stations wishing to check into this net? If so call now giving your call phonetically...OVER.

Log additional check ins.

Verify station count with the assistant NCS.

Have assistant NCS critique the session.

Proceed with information or comments for the net.
