DX Code Of Conduct

- I will listen, and listen, and then listen again before calling.
- I will only call if I can copy the DX station properly.
- I will not trust the DX cluster and will be sure of the DX station's call sign before calling.
- I will not interfere with the DX station nor anyone calling and will never tune up on the DX frequency or in the QSX slot.
- I will wait for the DX station to end a contact before I call.
- I will always send my full call sign.
- I will call and then listen for a reasonable interval. I will not call continuously.
- I will not transmit when the DX operator calls another call sign, not mine.
- I will not transmit when the DX operator queries a call sign not like mine.
- I will not transmit when the DX station requests geographic areas other than mine.
- When the DX operator calls me, I will not repeat my call sign unless I think he has copied it incorrectly.
- I will be thankful if and when I do make a contact.
- I will respect my fellow hams and conduct myself so as to earn their respect.

DX TIP OF THE MONTH "UP - UP - UP - UP"

Ever listen to a rare DX station calling CQ and all of a sudden you hear another station transmitting "UP UP" or the DX station themselves calling "CQ ab2xyz UP 5-10"? What the heck was that all about? Well, it is a normal practice for a rare DX station to transmit on one frequency and to receive on a range of frequencies away from their transmit frequency, this is called "Working Split". This is because everyone in the world is trying to make a QSO with this rare DX entity and if everyone called that entity on the same frequency, well, no one would make a contact. The split could be either UP or DOWN from their transmitting frequency by as little as 1 Khz to as much as 100Khz or more. The "UP UP" is coming from the "Frequency Police" as they are called. What is happening is that they are trying to let people know who are transmitting on the DX stations transmit frequency that the DX is listening on a different frequency.

In theory this sounds like a good idea for a couple of reasons. First of all, not everyone has a computer connected to a DX cluster to see the comments about previous contacts that a rare DX is "Working Split". Second, not all rare DX stations announce ALL the time that they are "Working Split". Most of the time, a rare DX station WILL announce that they are listening "UP 5-10 or whatever". And of course there is always someone who just makes a mistake and transmits right on the DX frequency. In reality, many times this type of help gets out of hand. For one thing, the "Frequency Police" are themselves causing QRM by transmitting on the desired DX frequency. It wouldn't be so bad if only one policeman was occasionally doing the announcing, but there are usually 2, 3, 4 or more transmitting all at the same time, thus obliterating the DX station entirely. And unfortunately, a few of them get VERY belligerent in their announcing.

So, the next time you hear "UP UP" or "UP 5-20" you will know what is going on. I would recommend that you follow rule number 1 of the "DX Code Of Conduct" found elsewhere is this newsletter. Also, check and double check that your radio is set for split operation if you are attempting to reach that rare DX and they are "Working Split". You will have better success making contacts and have more fun doing so.
